

E-Mail Address Policy

1. E-mail addresses are available to any paid up member. E-mail addresses will be limited to 2 addresses per family, unless you are a current bridge officer or event chair. In that case a third or more addresses would be available.
2. E-mail addresses will be considered abandoned if your membership dues become delinquent, by more than 2 months. At that point the beaver e-mail account will be deleted.
3. All e-mail sent to your.name@beavercreekboatclub.com will be automatically forwarded to an e-mail address you give the web design guy, either on paper or by e-mail. Don't tell him by phone or at a meeting the address, as he is very forgetful. Write it down for him.
4. The only reserved e-mail addresses will be the current bridge officers for example, Commodore, Secretary, or event chair, Steak.Fry@beavercreekboatclub.com. All other names will be accepted on a first come first served basis. If you wanted "1993Commodore" I don't see a problem. Names can be funny or weird or whatever you want, just keep the name clean.

You can use the following to request your personal e-mail account.

Beaver name (use a dot to separate more than 1 name prior to the @symbol)
