Harry and I will be gone for the month of February. If you notice any problems at the boat club please contact Al Zanni.

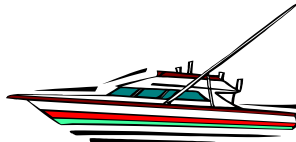
